

Evaluating Claims of Zapruder Film Alteration

Lack of Sprocket Hole Area Imagery Seen at NPIC

In a videotaped interview with [Dino Brugioni \(33:45\)](#), he commented that he saw no images between the sprocket holes (during his work at the first NPIC briefing board event):

Horne: Do you recall any image bleed-over?

Brugioni No.

Horne: Between the sprocket holes?

Brugioni: No.

In a meeting summary memo ([p. 14 - last full paragraph](#)), Doug Horne makes the following comment about Ben Hunter regarding the presence of images between the sprocket holes found at the second briefing board event at NPIC:

His impression is that the film was probably in 16 mm format, but was not of an unslit double-8 mm film. It was his strong impression that they were working with the original, but *when asked whether there were images present between the sprocket holes, he said that it was his reasonably strong impression today that there were no such images present between the sprocket holes in the film he examined at NPIC*. At one point he described the film as “not high resolution.”

If the recollections are accurate, this is damning evidence showing that either a copy or a completely different movie film was processed at the NPIC events.
